

## **Make your own Christingle**

Find something round, an orange, satsuma, apple, potato...

Now find four cocktail sticks, or something that will stick into it.

Find a small candle. A birthday cake candle is ideal.

Now find some red tape, ribbon or colour a strip of paper in red.  
This is to go around your 'orange'

Now find some small items of food that will go on your sticks such as raisins, sweets, cubes of cheese

### ***To build your Christingle:***

Put the candle in the top. You may need to make a hole to do this.

The 'orange' represents the world and the candle represents Jesus 'The Light of The World'

Then put your red ribbon, tape, paper around the middle of the orange and fasten in place using tape or a pin. This represents Jesus' love which is for all the world.

Now put your food onto the sticks and put them into the orange.

This represents the people in the four corners of the world and how God provides for us all.

As you light and look at your Christingle  
take a moment to thank God for all that he provides for us  
and remember that he loves each one of us.
