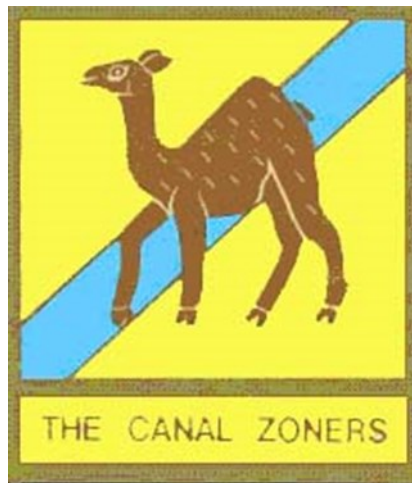

The Last Post (Standards dip)

THE EXHORTATION

The Minister or a senior member of the Branch shall recite:

“They shall grow not old, as we that are left grow old:

Age shall not weary them, nor the years condemn.

At the going down of the sun and in the morning

We will remember them”

Response: **We will remember them**

A poppy wreath is laid at the altar

THE SILENCE

The Reveille (Standards return to the Carry)

Reading – Isaiah 2: verses 1-4 (read by Peter Armstrong)

A brief history of the Standard – George Shotton

The President, Chairman or Representative of the Branch steps forward, takes the Standard and hands it to the officiating Minister saying:

“I commit this Sacred Standard of the Cumbria and North Lancashire Branch of the Canal Zoners to you as a priest of the Parish of Holy Trinity Kendal for safekeeping in the Church forevermore”.

The Minister replies:

“On behalf of the Parish Church of the Holy Trinity, Kendal, I accept the charge”.

Then the Minister shall say:

“May the souls of the faithful departed rest in peace”.

To which all will respond: **“And rise in Glory”.**
