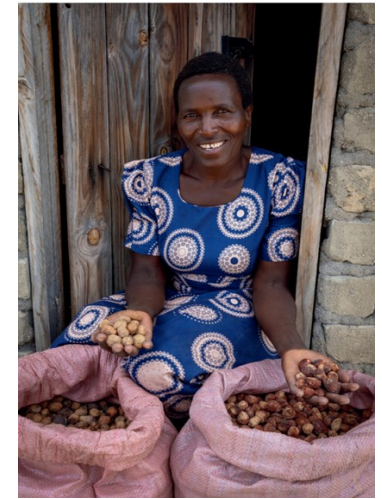
**Harvest Blessing** (bold statements said by all)
